

Call for RPN Subject Matter Experts for the Nursing Community Assessment Service (NCAS)

Casual employment opportunity

The Nursing Community Assessment Service (NCAS) is seeking RPNs to serve as subject matter experts and consultants in their assessment development process. NCAS recruits subject matter experts to write assessment cases and questions, develop and revise standards, validate their assessments, and help with field testing. The work is fairly flexible and will occur occasionally throughout the year.

What is NCAS?

NCAS is a competency-based assessment service for nursing professionals applying for practicing registration who cannot evidence that they meet the education and/or competency requirements for registration. It is a three-step assessment involving a computer-based assessment (which can be taken internationally), and a simulation lab assessment and oral assessment (which take place at Langara College in BC).

What are we looking for?

To be eligible, potential candidates must:

- Hold Practicing registration, in good standing, with CRPNBC
- Have at least 2 years' experience practising as an RPN
- Be familiar with the RPN Entry-Level Competencies
- Be able to work well in a small group
- Have solid IT skills; the work might involve using an online platform
- Be comfortable working intensively over a short period of time

Is there compensation?

Yes. NCAS will provide compensation at a rate of \$44 per hour.
